Kermadec Ocean Sanctuary Bill

My warm regards to you and your Board.

We have heard the ongoing concerns you have expressed on behalf of mandated iwi organisations in relation to the proposed sanctuary. Particularly that iwi consider the proposed sanctuary does not adequately protect the rights guaranteed in the 1992 Fisheries Deed of Settlement.

I am writing to advise that the Government intends to remove the Kermadec Ocean Sanctuary Bill from the Order Paper, which means the Bill will no longer be considered by Parliament.

[My colleagues and I would welcome the opportunity to meet with you and members of your Board next year to hear your views on marine protection more broadly.]

I have also written to the chairs of Ngāti Kuri and Te Aupōuri to let them know about the Government's decision in relation to the Bill.
