Thank you for your email of 9 June 2026 requesting the following under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

1. *All correspondence from 6 March 2026 to the present between you (or your office) and Guy Randall, Chief Executive of Wolfbrook Property Group, relating to Pegasus Golf Ltd, the Pegasus Golf Course site, or any associated land use, development, or planning matters.*
2. *This request includes, but is not limited to, emails, letters, text messages, or any other messaging platform, as well as briefings, aides-mémoire, or notes recording or summarising those communications.*
3. *Any letters, or advice provided to you from 6 March 2026 to the present relating to the Pegasus Golf Course site, and/or potential fast-track consenting.*

On 10 June 2026, my office contacted you to clarify the scope of the third point of your request. You responded on the same day, agreeing to refine the scope of this point as follows:

- *Any letters, advice, or any other written communication from other MPs and Ministers provided to you from 6 March 2026 to the present relating to the Pegasus Golf Course site, and/or potential fast-track consenting.*

I am refusing your requests in points 1 and 2 in full, under section 18(e) of the Act, as the information you have requested does not exist.

With regards to your refined third point, the Hon Matt Doocey messaged me about the Pegasus Golf Course, which I am releasing in full.

You have the right to seek an investigation and review by the Office of the Ombudsman of my decisions relating to this request, in accordance with section 28(3) of the Act. The relevant details can be found on their website at: www.ombudsman.parliament.nz.
