Dear s 9(2)(a)

Thank you for your emails of 12 February 2019 requesting the following under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

I request a copy of all surveys, polls or assessments of public opinion conducted by or on behalf of the Ministry for the Environment between 26 October 2017 and 12 February 2019.

I also request the total cost of each individual poll, survey or assessment of public opinion over the period.

And

I request a copy of the results of all surveys, polis or assessments of public opinion conducted by or on behalf of the Ministry for the Environment between 26 October 2017 and 12 February 2019.

There are two pieces of work that fall within the scope of your request.

First, in 2018 we published survey research into New Zealander's attitudes to environmental issues. The research was done in two parts, an initial survey and a later update. The initial research cost \$34,850. The update cost \$16,000.

The research was initiated by the Ministry to inform the development of policy advice, design public consultations in targeted and engaging ways, and provide insight into environmental attitudes to inform our stewardship role. It can be found on the Ministry website at:

The second piece of research was a small survey carried out to help us prepare for the release of our upcoming Environment Aotearoa 2019 report. The cost of this survey was \$3600. A copy of that survey is attached.

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#### Sample source

683 Respondents were sourced from Research Now/SSI— the largest New Zealand Chline panel.

#### **Audience and weighting**

New Zealanders aged 18 and over. Sample had the following dectas: age, gender, location, and ethnicity, to align with Stats NZ population counts from the 2013 census.

#### **Fieldwork**

Interviewing was carried out from the 140 October to 28th October 2018.

#### **Accuracy**

At a total sample lever the results have a maximum margin of error (at the 95% confidence interval) of +/-4.9%.

#### **Key findings**

8% involved in environmental actions on a regular basis 36% sometimes/50% not involved very much

47% care greatly

80% want to receive their environmental information in the news

Social media – 50% to their personal facebook page

Tools – 69% want simple actions that will make a difference/50% more local info

38% feel the environment is good but degrading 4% feel it is great




