Thank you for your email of 20 March 2019 requesting the following under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

- The number of service contracts that the Ministry for the Environment holds for cleaning and security services?
- The names of the companies that provide current Ministry for the Environment cleaning and security contracts?
- The scope of these contracts (which buildings do they cover in which cities and in which regions and the general nature of the services delivered?)
- The approximate annual cost of each of these contracts?
- The expiry date of each of these contracts?

On 27 March 2019 you confirmed that the figures for 2017/18 financial year would be suitable. On 2 April 2019 you clarified that your request covers all internal and external cleaning that "is a programmed continuous process rather than just being a one-off for emergency cleaning".

The following information provides a response to your questions regarding Ministry for the Environment (the Ministry) cleaning and security contracts for the 2017/18 financial year.

The Ministry for the Environment holds three contracts for cleaning and security. All contracts are for Environment House, Wellington. See the table below.
