Thank you for your email of 4 November 2019 requesting information under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) regarding the processes at the Ministry for the Environment (the Ministry) in responding to requests for official information:

*Please state definitively whether the MfE excludes responses to previous OIAs from subsequent OIA responses.*

*Can you please describe whether the MfE's policy for responding to OIAs has changed since my previous OIA (in which case please forward the guidance and related documents approving this change).*

Please note that material in scope of parts 1, 2, and 3 of your full request has been addressed in separate responses and sent to your previous FYI.org requests - these being the responses with the tracking numbers: 19-D-02214, 19-D-02216, and 19-D-02217. This letter specifically addresses the questions you have raised around the Ministry's approach to information requests.

The Ministry assesses and responds to requests for official information in accordance with the Act and Ombudsman and State Services Commission advice. There has been no change in the Ministry's approach to answering responses.

Each request for official information is evaluated to ensure that documents deemed to be in scope are identified. This includes previous requests for official information, provided that the response is in scope of the new request.

The Ministry acknowledges that we should have informed you of our intention to combine your three requests into a single response. We apologise for not doing so in this instance.
