Thank you again for your time at short notice on 21 February to discuss the request for call in of the proposed waste-to-energy facility in Te Awamutu. On this matter, with reference to the interests of iwi and Treaty settlements, we note that you expressed a strong interest in the

proposal and the Minister for the Environment's decision-making in considering a call in. You also raised concerns about the effects of the proposed activity. These matters have been conveyed to the Minister.

I anticipate being in a position to update you in March once the Minister has considered our initial advice. In the meantime, I hope the following information on the letters from the councils to the Minister requesting call-in will be of assistance:
