Yet another query re our plastics website pages

Currently we have this proposed text:

- Several recyclers across Aotearoa process plastic number 5 ([Compsec](#), [Pact Recycling](#), [RD Manufacturing](#), [Croxley Recycling](#), [Mammoth](#), and [Aotearoa NZ Made](#)). Comspec in Christchurch turns plastic containers numbered 5 into pellets that are sent to plastic manufacturers around the country to create a range of things including household and garden tools, containers, building materials and fibre for clothing.

Harry has noted Croxley (e-waste) and Mammoth (PET to insulation) don't publicly mention they do a polypropylene #5 product or recycling.

Do you have contacts for both those companies? If so would you mind either emailing them through to me or emailing them directly and finding out whether they mind being listed as a company that uses recycled plastic 5?
