Thank you for sending in your query and for your interest in household battery recycling.

All household batteries collected in recycling schemes in New Zealand are shipped overseas. The offshore processing of these collections will vary based on the type of batteries collected and the company organising the export.

Two of the largest companies organising household battery collections in New Zealand are [E-cycle](#) and [Interwaste](#). We recommend reaching out to either one of these companies if you'd like to know further information about their export destination(s) and/or processing.
