Minister Davis sent a letter to Minister Shaw (attached) on 7 September to inform him and David Parker about themes relating to the Environment and Climate Change portfolios which emerged from Crown/Māori relations engagement. The letter mentions a kaitiaki credit system — we're not sure exactly what this is, and it's not really explained in the letter (if you could explain this in the briefing (requested below), that'd be helpful).
