

## Zero Carbon Bill - Weekly Update: Monday 6 August - Friday 17 August

## Overall Status - Key messages

- A. 'Sprint' sessions undertaken 6-9 August resulted in initial advice to the Minister on the expected landing zones for policy recommendations. Feedback on this advice was discussed at the Officials meeting on 13 August.
- B. An early draft of the Cabinet paper and RIS have been sent to the Minister. Feedback on the narrative and structure of these documents has been requested along with the any substantial issues. While other agencies have been involved in analysing the options presented, some comments have yet to be incorporated due to time constraints. These, along with a full legal review will be incorporated into the next draft which will be provided to the Minister on 23 August. A final draft Cabinet paper and RIS will be sent to the Minister on 31 August. This will incorporate the economic analysis comparing the impact of the target.
- C. The team are working through how the principles of the Treaty could be reflected in the Bill with Iwi Chairs Forum, Pou Taiao and the Federation of Maori Authorities. The outcomes of these conversations aim to provide specific input into final policy recommendations. How these groups will be engaged during the drafting process is also being determined.
- D. The economic analysis is on track for delivery of first results on 24 August. A short summary will be developed by 26 August to give and overview of findings. This will inform the finalisation of policy recommendations in the Final Draft of the Cabinet Paper, RIS and Briefing Note. The summary will also form the basis of a Briefing Note on the modelling that will be submitted to the Minister on 31 August. The final modelling report is contractually agreed as due on 17 September, which is after lodgment. Negotiations are ongoing with NZIER to expedite this deliverable.
