
## Attachment 2 - Summary of intended changes to the existing work programme

- 1. **Attachment 1** identifies how the Ministry's departmental capacity and capability are expected to change from the compounding impacts of the expiry of time-limited funding, the mini-Budget and the baseline savings target.
- 2. The modelled reductions for each of the Ministry's business group are shown in the graph on the next page, alongside the potential effect of a successful RM budget bid.
- 3. This attachment (**Attachment 2**) is our initial assessment of how the Ministry's work programme will need to adapt to a significantly lower appropriation. It identifies the projects and services in each business unit that will be stopped, scaled, rescoped or continued.
- 4. It also identifies new work directed by Ministers, where this is known (e.g. under the coalition government 100-day work programme).
- 5. The status designated to each project or service is indicative only and needs to be confirmed through our upcoming business planning process for 2024/25. Our revised business plan cannot be finalised until we have confirmation on the size of our appropriation, which is dependent on the RM budget bid.
- 6. We will keep working with you to develop a work programme that responds to your priorities while also fulfilling the Ministry's statutory responsibilities.
