Key points:

- Avoid noting only papers unless something relates to public interest and controversy.
- Papers must be concise and no more than 10pages.
- Papers must be lodged on time.
- Consultation requirements must be met before submission of a paper see here.
 - Ensure that the bare minimum of five days Ministerial and political consultation is worked into your Cabinet paper timeline. Papers are often held up because of rushed political consultation.
