**Subject:** [Classification] Revision to public EV charger data in Target 9 report

Hi James and Jamie,

The Ministry of Transport has contacted the Climate IEB Unit with revised public EV charger data. This affects the Target 9 report, specifically the second page and the supporting indicator on public EV chargers.

Total chargers as at 1 July 2024 changed from 1,248 to 1,139. The estimate of charge points as at 19 April 2024 changed from 1,314 to 1,209.

Attached is the updated Target 9 report, with the second page updated for the Minister to approve. **The Target 9 report will be proactively released to Cabinet on Monday so we will need to advise DPMC asap if the Minister has any concerns about this.**

The Ministry of Transport has also provided us with an explanation about why the

revision was needed and the data system improvements they are making to ensure the error will not happen again (in italics below).

*The original charger numbers provided by EECA were from the first iteration of EECA's [public EV charger dashboard](#) (published in April 2024), which is now updated quarterly. When these numbers were being updated in late August, the QA process identified an error in the way the raw data drawn from EV Roam (the charger database managed by NZTA) was processed. The data included some chargers that should not have been included.*

*These chargers were flagged for deletion in EVRoam, but the 'installation status' in the database said the chargers were still 'in commission'. This mostly related to chargers operated by Vector, as they closed all of their public chargers (selling some to other charging providers). This meant the data from EECA's April update included some chargers that were no longer operational, and some that were double-counted as they were now being operated by another company.*

*To ensure this issue does not arise again, EECA is engaging with NZTA so chargers flagged for deletion can be modelled better in EVRoam. EECA is also making data team QA process changes to ensure the process is better equipped to catch issues like this in future.*
