Just a technical query – is the panel convenor also the panel chair for each application? So does that mean there are multiple convenors chairing panels? (Just helpful for us to understand the capacity constraints on the system.) Refer to sch 3(1) and (2) that specifies the panel convenor (in consultation with the Minister), appoints a panel chair but the convenor may act as chairperson of a panel instead of appointing another person as chair. Please note there is only one convenor, whos role is to set up all the panels.

The response re conditions is rather broad. We think it needs qualifying, consistent with the Rec 2 suggested text in Vic's message. The current working version of the document has an expanded response of the following (and we will discuss Vics email):

We agree that any amendments need to preserve the power for the expert panel to set any conditions they consider appropriate.
