

Appendix 1: Contents of draft Notice of Motion to establish Ad-hoc Select Committee

Purpose of the Committee for Climate Adaptation

- 1. The purpose of the Committee for Climate Adaptation is to work towards building consensus on New Zealand's approach to climate adaptation.
- 2. The scope of climate adaptation for the purpose of this Committee is:
 - Where people live and work and the associated infrastructure, including future development.
 - Initial focus on impacts from severe weather events and climate changeexacerbated risks.
 - Decision-making principles to guide:
 - i. proactive actions to reduce risks before a major event occurs
 - ii. responses following a major severe weather event.

Role of the Committee for Climate Adaptation

- 3. The Committee for Climate Adaptation will:
 - undertake an inquiry into climate adaptation (see Appendix 2);
 - consider any adaptation legislation referred to it by the House.

Timeframes

4. The Committee for Climate Adaptation would be established until a Climate Adaptation Bill has received its Third Reading.

Other matters

- 5. The notice of motion should include details of the transfer of submissions from the Environment Committee inquiry on climate adaptation and enable consideration of these.
