**COVID-19 Recovery (Fast-Track Consenting) Act 2020 – request for further information  
– Beachside Mission Bay Project**

Thank you for Drive Holdings Limited's application to refer the Beachside Mission Bay Project to an expert consenting panel for consideration under the COVID-19 Recovery (Fast-track Consenting) Act 2020 (FTCA).

Under delegated authority from the Minister for the Environment (the Minister), I am writing to request the following further information under section 22 of the FTCA:

1. Supporting evidence demonstrating financial capability to fund and deliver the project
2. Whether the project description and scope will require resource consent for subdivision
3. The number of direct full-time equivalent (FTE) jobs which will be created by the project, expressed as direct FTEs per year
4. The time required to address FTCA requirements regarding engagement with relevant iwi authorities on the need (or otherwise) for cultural impact assessments.

Please provide the required information via return email within 10 working days so that the Minister can take it into account when deciding whether to accept the referral application.

Please note the Minister is not required to consider information provided after this time but he may do so at his discretion.
