Historical data includes Greenhouse Gas Inventory data up to 2021 and adjusted baseline data for 2022. The 2022 figure is consistent with the <u>Second</u> <u>emissions reduction plan (ERP2) discussion document</u> and includes adjustments because of subsequent Stats NZ livestock and fertiliser revisions.
