The general feedback has been in opposition to the project, specifically seeking a significantly reduced yield for the Site. The Applicant has responded to this feedback and has reduced the number of dwellings by five. Any further reduction in the number of units at the Site is contrary to the planned outcomes for the Residential – Mixed Housing Suburban zone, which enables intensification, while retaining a suburban built character. The project responds to the suburban built character of the immediate urban environment through generally two storey detached and attached housing in a variety of types and sizes to provide housing choice both within the project and in the broader context of Wattle Downs.
