We require some further information to process your Fast-track application: 'Impact Marine - Sustainable and Climate-Resilient Aquaculture on Land in the Bay of Plenty'.

The property title provided as part of your application, notes that the parcels are "identified as potentially Māori Freehold Land."

Clause 18 of the Fast-track Bill specifies ineligibility criteria, including the following:

A project must not include any of the following activities:

(a) an activity that—

- (i) would occur on land returned under a Treaty settlement or on identified Māori land; and
- (ii) has not been agreed to in writing by the relevant landowner:
