Kia ora,

This does not appear to be ineligible.

It would affect public conservation land in the Kaimai Range. Identified potential ecological effects include the impacts of stream diversion and earthworks near wetland areas, and impacts to bats, lizards and native birds.

The application would need to consider the national pest management plan for kauri dieback (*Phytophthora agathidicida*), and should have a risk management plan in place.

The Environmental Law Institute currently has a claim in the Waitangi Tribunal alleging breaches of Te Tiriti for the activity that Matamata Metal Supplies have impacted the sacred ancestor maunga of Ngāti Hinerangi hapū o Raukawa, Te Weraiti.

Iwi authorities and Treaty Settlement entities in the area are Ngāti Hinerangi, Ngāti Raukawa, Ngāti Haua.
