Good morning Oliver,

Thank you for your email below, Murray Francis has passed it on to me to provide some more detail. Consultation has been undertaken with the Canterbury Regional Council (CRC) in respect of applications for quarrying on the site and an application had previously been lodged with CRC to discharge contaminants to air for quarrying under reference CRC215041. The application document can be viewed [here](#) if that assists. Subsequently, Road Metals has obtained a "global" discharge to air permit (for the whole Canterbury Region) from CRC under references CRC223586 and CRC223587, removing the need for CRC215041. This global permit provides for quarrying to limited levels (up to 100 days per year, with required setbacks, handling limits and specified mitigation measures) on the site subject to obtaining the other necessary approvals, although additional consents may be sought in the future to increase the scale of activities beyond what this permit provides for. The need for such consents, or otherwise compliance with plan rules, were also discussed with CRC prior to withdrawing CRC215041. On that basis, these discussions did not necessarily "inform" the proposal, however the proposal was certainly made in light of the CRC global consents, and having discussed additional consents that may be required. For completeness, we note that the proposal doesn't immediately trigger any other resource consents from ECan, although a water take consent from an existing on site bore would likely be progressed subsequently to assist with vegetation establishment and dust suppression.
