Kia ora,

We don't know of a reason why this project would be ineligible.

The project would require a Wildlife Act authority to relocate lizards, frogs and birds during vegetation removal.

DOC may benefit from access to this block for pest control purposes, however we also have concerns about the potential impact of the project on species living in the area. Any earthworks would need to comply with the National PA Pest Management Plan (to control kauri dieback).

The project site is within Te Patukirikiri's area of interest and we would recommend engaging with them about this.
