



Could you please provide comment on:

- 1. whether the project requires any other related approvals from your agency.
 - Activities that involve the capture, handling or killing of protected wildlife will require appropriate Wildlife Act Authorisations to be in place.
 - Concessions may be required if infrastructure or activities associated with the establishment of infrastructure pass through Public Conservation Land. Public Conservation Land in the general vicinity of the project include (but may not be limited to): Onaero River Marginal Strip (s.24(3) Fixed Marginal Strip, Onaero River Scenic Reserve (s.19(1)(a) Scenic Reserve), Marginal Strip Onaero Coast (s.24(3) Fixed Marginal Strip), Marginal Strip Urenui River (s.24(1) & (2) Moveable Marginal Strip) and Mataro Scenic Reserve (s.19(1)(a) Scenic Reserve).

- 4. Do you know of any history of compliance issues with the applicant regarding conservation approvals?
 - No other compliance issues beyond what has already been declared by the applicant (relevant to this project).

- 1. Is any public conservation land affected?
 - Public Conservation Land in the general vicinity of the project include (but may not be limited to): Onaero River Marginal Strip (s.24(3) Fixed Marginal Strip, Onaero River Scenic Reserve (s.19(1)(a) Scenic Reserve), Marginal Strip Onaero Coast (s.24(3) Fixed Marginal Strip), Marginal Strip Urenui River (s.24(1) & (2) Moveable Marginal Strip) and Mataro Scenic Reserve (s.19(1)(a) Scenic Reserve).
- 2. Are there any potential issues affecting wildlife?
 - More detailed assessments of the remnant native vegetation and wetland areas in the project areas should be considered, as well as lizard monitoring.
- 3. Is any area a national park or Ramsar site or wildlife sanctuary?
 - No, the project area does not include within its boundary a National Park, Ramsar site, or wildlife sanctuary.
- 4. Is there any treaty settlement/s related to the project site?
 - Ngāti Mutunga Claims Settlement Act 2006
 - Conservation-related obligations Statutory acknowledgements over the following sites: Onaero River Scenic Reserve, Onaero Coast Marginal Strip, Onaero River Marginal Strip, Urenui River Marginal Strip, Onaero River and Urenui River. Deeds of recognition covering: Onaero River Scenic Reserve; Onaero River; Urenui River. Sites that have been transferred back to iwi (Ngāti Mutunga): Onaero Domain Recreation Reserve and Urenui Domain Recreation Reserve. These Recreation Reserves are administered by the NPDC.
