Kia ora,

We don't know of a reason why this project would be ineligible.

It does include several parcels of PCL in the Kaimai Mamaku Conservation Park. Potential ecological effects include significant loss of indigenous vegetation and habitat for fauna - native birds such as whitehead, kaka, karearea, threatened striped skink, long and short-tail bats.

Proposed diversion of natural waterways could have significant impacts on native fish.

The project should also include a risk mitigation plan for kauri dieback.

Relevant iwi authorities and Treaty settlement entities are:

- Ngāti Ranginui
- Hapū Ngāti Te Wai, Pirirakau
- Ngai Te Rangi
- Ngai Tamawhariua
- Te Whānau a Tauwhao ki Ōtawhiwhi

There is a current active compliance issue for an ongoing non-compliance, illegal occupancy. Formal Notice Letter was provided in March 2024 and 30 days' notice has lapsed with no response or action from Katikati Quarries. Applicant mentions 2016 issue, there is also an encroachment Breach of Access Arrangement from 2020/21, where advice was sought to cease operation.
