We don't know of any reason why this project would be ineligible; no public conservation land is directly affected by the project area.

However, the majority of the project area is subject to a DOC conservation covenant and this would require approval. A Wildlife Act authorisation would be needed for any disturbance to lizards.

Presence of archaeological and heritage sites would also require approval separately from Heritage NZ Pouhere Taonga.

This site is also part of the Ngāi Tahu Claims Settlement Act protocol area.
