We do not know of reasons why this project would be ineligible.

It affects two PCL sites, which are both stewardship land – Mt Rochfort Conservation Area and Waimangaroa-Granity Conservation Area.

The project would require an Access Arrangement under the CMA (either new or variations to existing AAs), Wildlife Act permits, and concessions including easements. They may also require permission under Freshwater Fisheries regulations for culverts, diversions etc.
