We need to know what, if any, PCL is directly affected by the project and the status of that land, to confirm it is not ineligible.

- No PCL affected

It helps to know if there are any wildlife, freshwater fisheries or land access permissions for mining which may require DOC approvals.

- Wildlife Act Permit

- Approval by Senior Heritage Advisor for ground disturbance within 200m of Archaeological sites.

We also need to know if there are any Treaty settlements which may be affected that we can advise to MfE.

- The site is within Protocol Area - Port Nicholson Block (Taranaki Whānui ki Te Upoko o Te Ika). No conflict of DOC Protocols with this proposal
- There are no other Treaty Settlement overlays.
