Greg Hunt has a well-established and varied background which encompasses property development, company management, strategic planning, project management, master planning, construction and resource management, the wine business and winery tourism, and the running of large-scale concerts/events.

Greg graduated with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Landscape Architecture and Planning from California University and practiced in the United States for eight years with an emphasis on Master Planned Communities, Resort Master Planning, and Hotels.

In 1993 Greg returned to New Zealand as the General Manager of Design and Development at Millbrook Resort. In addition, he oversaw the design and construction of the Wharf Casino in Queenstown.

In 1999 Greg left Millbrook to form Infinity Investment Group with Bob & Jen Robertson. His responsibilities were the master planning and consenting of developments.

In 2007 Greg established High Definition Limited, whose projects include Gibbston Valley Lodge & Spa, and the Gibbston Valley Station Resort and Golf Course.

Greg has been CEO of Gibbston Valley Winery since December 2009 and is the CEO and an owner of the Gibbston Valley Resort. He is responsible not only for the Winery, but the master planning and development of the Lodge & Spa next to the Winery. The Gibbston Valley Resort, across the road from the Winery, is currently in the early stages of development. Greg, with his experience as a Landscape Architect and Planner, developed the design for the resort and then oversaw the approval of the resort zone. Going forward, he will oversee the landscape design and installation for the resort.

Gibbston Valley Winery is also a partner in Greenstone Entertainment who promote the annual Summer Concert Series in Whitianga, Taupo, and Gibbston. These have been held since 2011.
