Good morning Phil,

Thank you for your application for Hunua Quarry Development for listing in the Fast-track Approvals Bill.

Under clause 16 of the Fast-track Approvals Bill, applicants must undertake engagement with specific groups before lodging a referral application, and include a record of the engagement and statement explaining how it has informed the project.

In this application, a number of groups are identified as potentially affected by the project, including mana whenua and Auckland Council. However the application does not record any engagement with Auckland Council regarding the quarry development, or state how that informed the project.

Please can you provide some information about engagement undertaken (if any) with Auckland Council on this project, and how that has informed the project?

I also note that you have put your name down as the submitter of the project (applicant), but that Winstone Aggregates is noted throughout the application in a way that would appear they are the applicant (they have legal interest in the land via Fletcher Concrete and Infrastructure, have held consultation with mana whenua).

Could you please confirm who is the applicant for this project?
