Mōrena,

We do not know of any reason why the Hunua Quarry Development would be ineligible.

There is no PCL within the project area, and we have not identified any issues affecting wildlife that would be in addition to permits required under the Wildlife Act that the applicant has already noted.

The following Treaty settlement redress includes the project area:

- Ngāti Tamaoho Statutory Acknowledgment – Otūwairoa Stream and its tributaries incl. Waipokapū Stream, Mangapū Stream and Waihoehoe Stream; Conservation Protocol Area
- Tāmaki Collective – Right of Refusal, Conservation Protocol Area
- Ngai Tai ki Tāmaki – Conservation Protocol Area.
