DESCRIPTION OF LAND ADJOINING LIMITED ACCESS ROAD

PURSUANT to subsection (1) of Section 4 of the Public Worke Amendment Act 1963 the National Roads Board has, by notice published in the New Zeeland Cazette duted 2 SEP 1977 and publicly notified, declare that portion of State Highway No 1 adjoining the above described feel to be 1 limited access road and the National Roads Board hereby gives you as owner/occupier of the shows described land notice pursuant to sub-section (5) of Section 4 of the Public Works Amendment Act 1963 that the National Roads Board authorizes/allocates (subject to the conditions specified below) the crossing place(s) marked on the plan number MOW LA10/23/2 a copy of which is available for inspection 35 at the office of The Resident Engineer, Ministry of Works and Davelopmant, Takepuna at which crossing place(a) vehicles or cettle may proceed to and from State Highway No 1 from and to the above-described land.

CONDITIONS

If and when the owner/occupier desires to construct or reconstruct the entrance(s) the following conditions shall apply:

- 1. Width of crossing place to be made not greater than 6/9 matres
- 2. The crossing place(s) is/are to be located only where approved in writing by the Resident Engineer, Ministry of Works and Davelopment, Takepune <u>OR</u> where existing at the date of this notice, that is: approximately 2 matres along the highway frontage fram: the date of this notice, that is: approximately 2 matres along the highway frontage fram: the date of the boundary nearest Albany.
- 3. Junction of the crossing place(s) with the highway/corriageway to be to the satisfaction of the Resident Engineer, Ministry of Works and Development, P D Box 33-255, Takepuns.

NOTES: For your information the provisions of sub-sections (5), (6), (7), (9) and (12) of Section 4 of the Public Works Amondment Act 1963 are not out below.

(a) The Matines Reads Board in the case of any limited access road under its control, and the local authority in respect of any limited access road under its control, was from time to time.

- - (a) By notice to the owner of the percet of land effected,
 - Authorise, subject to such conditions (if any) as it may exectfy, any swerified crossing place at which venicles hav proceed to and from any limited access road from and to any specified percel of land.
 - (ii) Cance) any such authorisation if the percel of land will still have seasonally practicable legal access to some other road or street or will still have some other authorised crossing place.
 - (IIII) Cancel or very eny such conditions or impose further conditions.
 - (b) Construct any access road that it may be expedient to construct to give access, whether additional or not, to any land adjoining or near the limited access cond.
 - (c) In the same manner so it declares any road to be a limited access road, revoke any such declaration.
- (6) with restricting any provision of any other Act, it is hereby declared that no person chall drive or move any vehicle or cattle, or permit any vehicle or cattle to be driven as moved, and or from any limited access road, except;
 - (a) in a case where a flate Highway or read or part thereof has been declared under subsection (1) or subsection (2) of this section to be a limited access road, at a motorway, road, street, or service lane from which vahicles eight leviully co-driven or moved onto the State Migheay or road or part thereof immediately before that declaration; or
