Community Project	2021 Limited	at 1350 Dairy Flat Highway, Silverdale, Auckland including operational buildings, 40 visitor accommodation units, a 20-unit wellness retreat, a restaurant, data centre and 7-hectare solar farm to provide power to the surf park. The project will include construction of infrastructure for three-waters services, roading, site access and parking, landscaping and planting, and revegetating a stream corridor.
