COVID-19 Recovery (Fast-Track Consenting) Act 2020 – comments sought on referral application – Auckland Surf Park Community Project

The Minister for the Environment (Minister) has received an application from AW Holdings 2021 Limited to refer the Auckland Surf Park Community Project (project) to an expert consenting panel (a panel) for consideration under the COVID-19 Recovery (Fast-track Consenting) Act 2020 (FTCA).

The purpose of the FTCA is to promote employment to support New Zealand's recovery from the economic and social impacts of COVID-19 and to support certainty of investment while continuing to promote the sustainable management of natural and physical resources.

The project is described in Appendix A and the application documents are in Attachment 1.

Auckland Transport may have an interest in the project because it may impact the local road network. Under delegated authority from the Minister and pursuant to section 21(3) of the FTCA, I invite Auckland Transport's written comments on the referral application. A template is provided for this purpose in Attachment 2.


The above information is provided to you in confidence and as part of the statutory process set out in the FTCA. Please do not forward the application or request for comments to anyone outside your organisation.

If the Minister accepts the application and the project are referred to a panel, the applicant will be able to lodge applications with the Environmental Protection Authority for the approvals needed under the Resource Management Act 1991. The applicant must provide a detailed assessment of environmental effects and cultural impact assessment(s) as part of this process.

Please provide comments via return email within 10 working days to ensure that the Minister takes them into consideration when deciding whether or not to accept the referral application. Note that the Minister is not required to consider any comments provided after this time.

Auckland Surf Park Community Project	AW Holdings 2021 Limited	<p>The project is to construct and operate a surf park at 1350 Dairy Flat Highway, Silverdale, Auckland including operational buildings, 40 visitor accommodation units, a 20-unit wellness retreat, a restaurant, data centre and 7-hectare solar farm to provide power to the surf park. The project will include construction of infrastructure for three-waters services, roading, site access and parking, landscaping and planting, and revegetating a stream corridor.</p> <p>The project involves activities such as clearing vegetation, carrying out earthworks, discharging stormwater and contaminants to land, discharging wastewater to land, taking, diverting and discharging groundwater, constructing buildings, installing a solar farm, a surf pool and associated infrastructure and structures, landscaping and planting.</p>
