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## MFE CYBER SECURITY WARNING

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Good-morning,

I write on behalf of Brookby Quarries Limited. This is the full response to the two questions raised by the MFE.

1. How do you anticipate that the project will be funded?

The project will be self-funded by the shareholder of Brookby Quarries Limited.

- 2. What approvals or authorisations do you anticipate you will need to obtain in order to undertake ecological offsetting and compensation?
- a. When you do anticipate you will be able to obtain those approvals?
- b. If you are unable to obtain approvals, do you anticipate the project will result in significant adverse effects that cannot be offset?

At this stage it is unlikely resource consents will be required for the various components of the ecological off-setting and compensation.

A permit will be required from the Department of Conservation for the relocation of any lizards. Bioresearches already hold such a permit for Stage 2 and it is considered that the risk of not obtaining a new permit for Stage 3 is very low. This permit is sought after resource consents have been granted.

Landowner agreements are required from a range of parties for the proposed ecological offsetting and compensation being undertaken on their properties. At the time of lodging the application the draft agreements are proposed to be in place and will be included as part of the consenting package. These agreements are not finalised until resource consents are granted as they may need to be modified in consultation with the landowners as a result of consent conditions.

If for any reason the applicant is unable to obtain the draft landowner agreements referred to above then the applications will not be pursued under this process as these are required in order for the proposed mitigation/off-setting/compensation package to be tabled as part of the application to address the ecological effects that will arise from Brookby Stage 3.
