Kia ora Karen,

Thanks for answering a few questions I had on the Easter Porirua Regeneration Project (EPRP) Infrastructure Work application you have made under the COVID-19 Recovery (Fast Track Consenting) Act.

As discussed can you please provide the following information so we can continue to assess the application:

1. Confirmation that the applicants are seeking the ability to apply for the consents and designations outlined in Table 1 below.
2. Further detail on what they employment figures (in FTEs) will be over the first two to three years of the project. I note your comments that one of the intentions of this project over the first few years is to provide training to local people to increase the capacity of the work force, and provide them with skills in civil construction.
3. A brief assessment of how the Main Trunk Main works in the stream bed and wetlands will be consistent with the National Policy Statement for Freshwater Management 2020. I note your comments that works in wetlands may not be required, however your have assumed they are in your application to ensure all effects can be considered.
