The E8 Mount Eden Viewshaft falls over the western portion of the site which is proposed to accommodate portions of Towers B, C and D.

The viewshaft height is illustrated in Concept Sections (Attachment 3) that we sent to MfE on the 31 May. This height illustrated on the sections is derived from 'above ground level' as per the requirements set in Schedule 9 (Volcanic Viewshafts Schedule) of the AUP (utilising NZVD2016).

We can confirm that the development (all of the towers affected) will not intrude into the viewshaft and would be a permitted activity under D.14.4.1 (A1).
