Man Street Hotel – Queenstown Project	The Queenstown Hotel NZ Limited Partnership	The project is to construct and operate a hotel up to 6 storeys (20.6 metres) in height above an existing 2-storey basement car parking building at 12-26 Man Street, Queenstown and the adjacent road reserve. The hotel will include approximately 175-185 guest rooms, loading zone and connections to existing infrastructure. The project site is a strata title covering the airspace above a carpark building (which is on a separate title), and the project proposes to construct above this carpark. All height limits in the Queenstown Lakes District Plan relating to the site are above the podium level of this carpark. The project involves activities such as demolishing buildings and structures, constructing buildings, constructing vehicle access, loading and parking areas, discharging stormwater to land.
