

On 05 November 2020 the Minister for the Environment, Hon David Parker, (the Minister), accepted referral of the approved the Ohinewai Foam Factory project (Project) to an expert consenting panel (panel) under the COVID-19 Recovery (Fast-track consenting) Act 2020 (FTCA) and provided you with a Notice of Decision (NoD) on 05 November 2020

As discussed with Stuart Penfold we did refer your Project but did not include all the information in the NoD. This letter highlights the additional information that was not provided in the NoD to ensure completeness of your records.

Information requirements

The Minister directed you to provide information on the greenhouse gas implications of the gasses used in the foam production process.
