As the Coastal Commercial Zone does not apply to the site we would respectfully ask thar all references to it are ignored and we apologies for any inconvenience caused. The presence (or not) of the Coastal Commercial Zone at the site does not change the Discretionary Activity status of the reclamation or associated activities which applies anywhithe General Marine zone where a site is not within any identified regionally significant area.
