Kia ora,

In March 2021, Contact Energy announced a six-year partnership with consultancy Roaring40s Wind Power Ltd to develop a pipeline of wind farm development opportunities to meet New Zealand's growing demand for renewable electricity.

One of the first sites we're looking to develop is a wind farm near Mimihau. The project would consist of approximately 50 wind turbines spread over Jedburgh Station and Venlaw Forest. A wind farm project (known as the Slopedown wind farm) was considered previously at this location more than 10 years ago by a different developer.

We estimate the generation capacity for the project will be between 230–300MW, and the generation output could be in the range 900–1200GWh/annum. This is enough electricity to power 150,000 households per year – making a significant contribution to future electricity demand.

As someone who lives close to the project, we wanted to let you know early in the development process and provide you with the opportunity to discuss the project with us.
