### **Subdivision Consent Application**

Operative North Shore District Plan

- Subdivision of eight lots in the Residential 1 zone, complying with the minimum and average site area requirements and being a restricted discretionary activity under Rule 9.4.5.1;
- Subdivision of one lot in the Rural 2 zone that is less than the 2ha minimum in Rule 9.4.7.2 and being a non complying activity under Rule 3.10.2.2; and
- Subdivision of two lots that in part do not follow the Residential 1 and Rural 2 boundary as required under Rule 9.4.4.6 and being a non complying activity under Rule 3.10.2.2.

- New impervious area of approximately 1,944m<sup>2</sup> with construction of the subdivision road, being a restricted discretionary activity under Part 3 Chapter H Rule 4.14.1.
- Stormwater flows from future dwellings with impervious areas of more than 25m<sup>2</sup> within a Stormwater
   Management Area Flow 1 Area, being a controlled activity under Rule 4.14.2.1.
