

Appendix 8A – Details on timing of NZHPT application

The building being relocated is not classified as a heritage building by either NZHPT or the Auckland Unitary Plan, and so we anticipate that there will not be significant difficulty obtaining authority to move the building. To provide the most certainty to NZHPT about the long-term future of the building, an alternative site would need to be identified, and it is proposed to commence that work in conjunction with the preparation of the resource consent. We anticipate that the three to four month process for consenting under the NZHPT will align quite well with the fast track consenting process. However if MfE has concerns with not seeking immediate NZHPT authority, we would look to file the NZHPT application immediately.
