Please find some brief info re Green Gorilla C&D waste diversion services.

We trust this assists to fill in the gaps for the last point of your Item 6 (*How waste will be minimised on site during construction & whether any parts of the existing building will be reused / recycled or repurposed*).

The role of waste minimisation on site is usually the responsibility of the building company engaged to build the project. We work closely with that company to assist with our knowledge and suggestions re designing out and reducing waste prior to it ending up in our bins.

We also assess room available on site to sort various waste types like steel, hard fill/concrete, plasterboard and perhaps timber. Typically there isn't a lot of room so we provide a mixed waste bin and deliver it to our Waste Processing facility where it is sorted, separated and wherever possible processed for reuse (see attached info re end use or 3rd party recycling partners).
